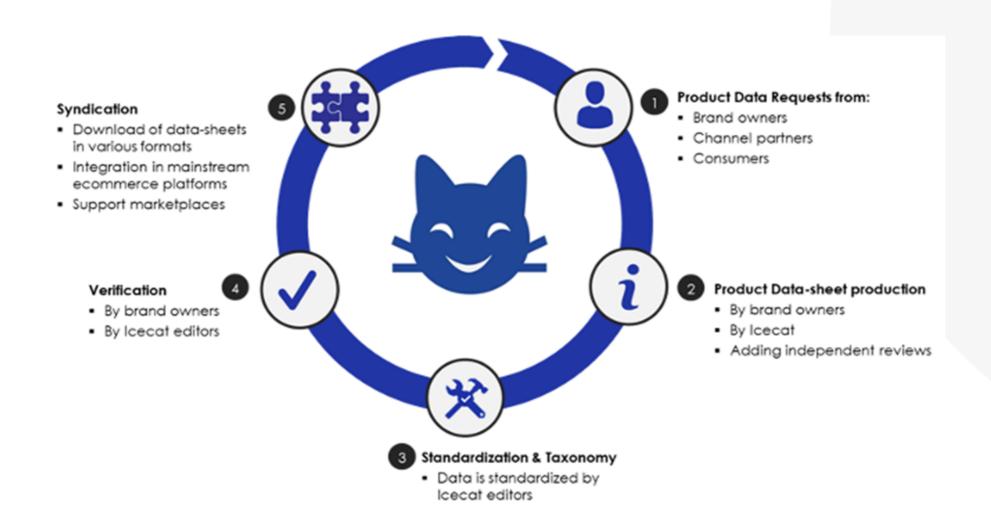

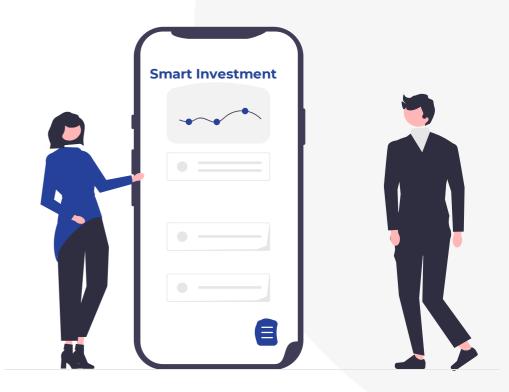




H1-2022 Business Summary

 - 2021 annual figures: auditor now wraps up audit



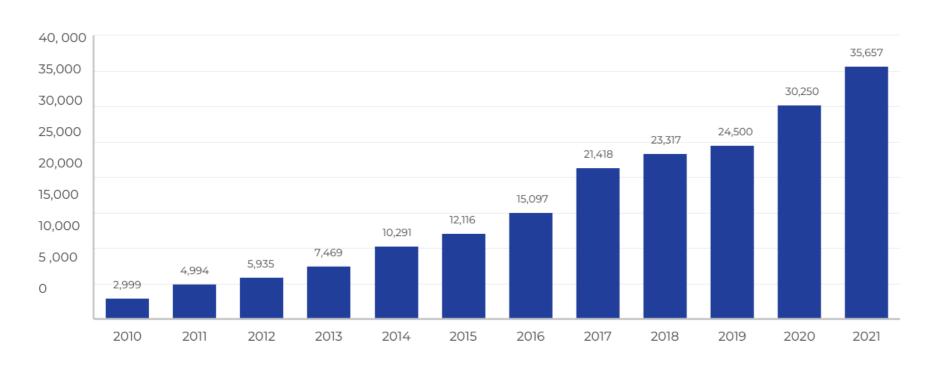

2010-2021 (Full Icecat)



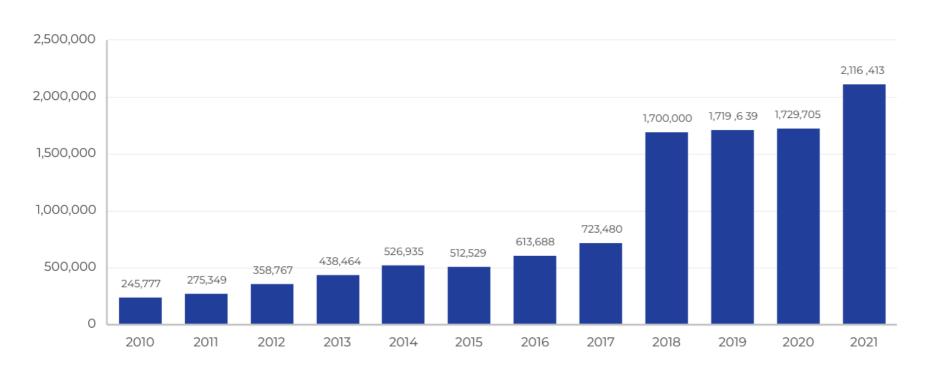




Non-financial KPIs: +24% production hike to 1.3M data-sheets in H1-2022; datasheet cost decreased -13%

2010 - 2021

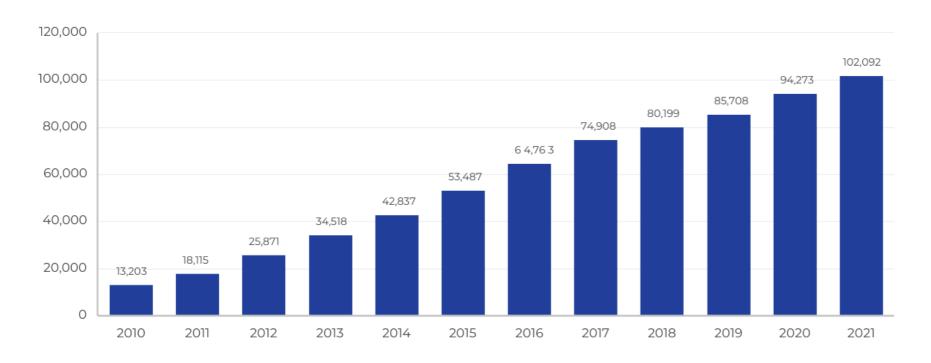




Non-financial KPIs: 8.6 Bio (+48%) downloads H1-2022 by 106K (+8%) users

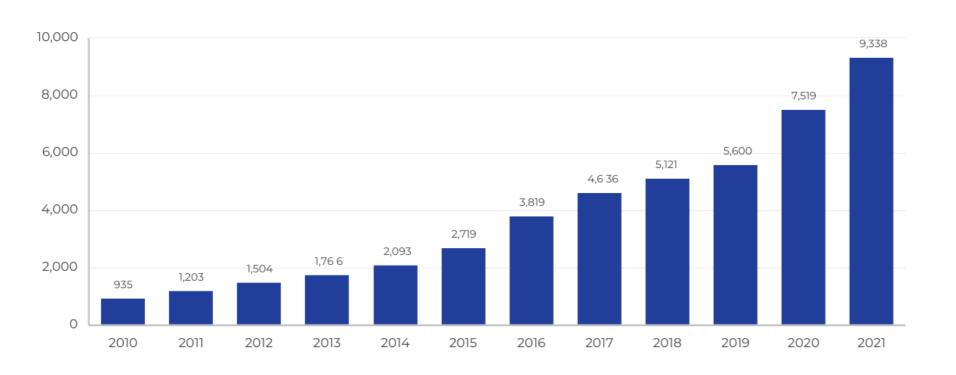




Non-financial KPIs: Categories Supported

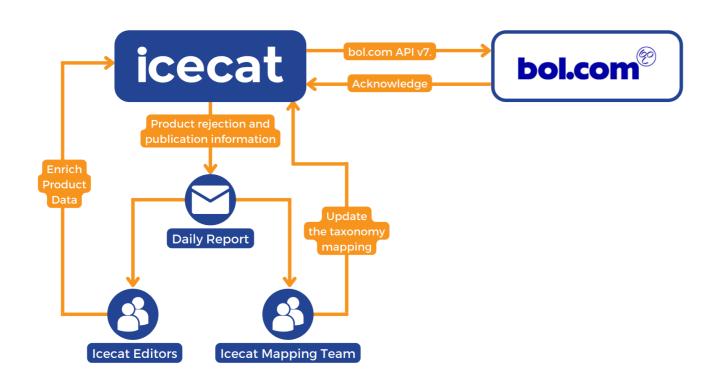

Changes in competition: rationalization phase; classic global (US) competitors faltering

- Salsify (US): no further acquisitions
- 1WorldSync (US) rationalizes Content Solutions (CNET CS)
- Syndigo (US): no further acquisitions
- GfK announces merger with Nielsen IQ
 - Advent (Nielsen IQ) has majority in combination
 - Rationalization of the analytics industry
 - Etilize lost VP global sales and appears no focus
 - Logically brandbank (NielsenIQ) is combined with Etilize
- Productsup swoops up World Of Content (out of cash)
- Icecat: talks
 - Fund: Virtuagym minority investment



Changes in the Board

New appointments per Jan 1, 2022:

- Guillaume Stritmatter CTO
- René Rozendal CBDO

The other directors and ordinary board members remain in post



Risks

- Consolidation and shake-out in E-commerce market
- Global Market-Places could become too dominant
- War in Ukraine might (again) disrupt local work force
- Supply chain disruptions affect e-commerce
- Investments in ventures might not continue to pay off
- Stagflation scenarios
- Depressed financial markets leading to lower valuations
- Increased competition in our PIMS space
- Modified legal frameworks regarding content use
- Other risks as identified in the prospectus and other communications



Impact of the War in Ukraine

- Contingency plans are executed
- After evacuation most staff returned home; some abroad
- UAid.charity is highly appreciated by UA colleagues
- Istanbul office is more than a fallback now
- Systems run all safe in the EU or US
- After a few weeks of turbulence all UA dev and editorial teams are back to speed
- We received many applications as a solid employer in UA
- We paused our (limited) commercial business in Russia
- The direct impact of the war on our business is neglectable
